
Founded in 1947 as *The Jolsonairs*, reorganized in 1950, and ultimately renamed *The International Al Jolson Society* in 1958, the mission statement of the Jolson Society is: "To protect and perpetuate the legacy of Al Jolson."

Membership in the Society provides many opportunities for those people around the world who share enthusiasm for "The World's Greatest Entertainer." Members receive two Jolson Journals annually – one in the spring and one in the fall – plus periodic newsletters concerning the latest activities of the Society. To add to the enjoyment, each issue includes special features, such as:
